Over the past few years, the Tribal Council members have been working toward a better future for our members. We have created and maintained several programs that assist our members in various ways.


- * A program that provides low-income families with financial assistance for heating costs and monthly rent.

Spring has finally sprung! Let's get grilling!

Grilled Salmon with Mango Salsa



Ingredients

- * 4 6-ounce salmon fillets
- * I teaspoon garlic powder
- * I teaspoon chili powder
- * salt and pepper to taste
- * juice of I lime

mango salsa

- * 2-3 mangos, diced
- * 1/2 red pepper, diced
- * 1/2 red onion, diced
- * I jalapeño, Seeded & finely chopped
- * 1/4 cup packed chopped cilantro

Instructions

- 1. In a medium bowl stir together mangos, red peppers, onions, jalapeños, and cilantro. Set aside until ready to use.
- 2. Stir together garlic powder, chili powder, and salt and pepper (I used about 1/2 teaspoon each). Rub mixture into salmon fillets. Grill over medium heat for 6-8 minutes on each side.
- 3. Squeeze fresh lime juice over grilled salmon, then top with mango salsa and serve.
